

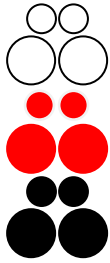


# Nampa-Tsi Lodge

## Coup Thong Guide



### Tenure beads



- Vigil Honor - white beads (one pair)  
one additional pair for each additional year  
*Note: one pair of large beads can be substituted for ten pairs of small beads*
- Brotherhood - red beads (one pair)  
one additional pair for each additional year  
*Note: one pair of large beads can be substituted for ten pairs of small beads*
- Ordeal – black beads (one pair)  
one additional pair for each additional year  
*Note: one pair of large beads can be substituted for ten pairs of small beads*

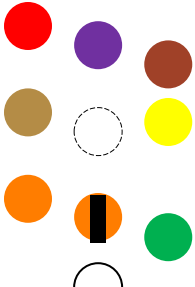
### Recognition Beads – adult beads may be worn in any order within this area.

*Note: adults have the choice of wearing the adult flat beads for any beads earned as a youth.*

- Purple Camp staff
- Dark Brown Elangomat
- Light Brown Nimat
- Clear Vigil Guide
- Yellow Ceremony Team member (as a youth)
- Orange OR NOAC participant
- Orange with Black Stripe NOAC staff
- Green Chapter Adviser
- White Lodge vice chief (as a youth)

### Youth beads may be worn in any order within this area.



- Red Eagle Scout
- Purple Camp staff
- Dark Brown Elangomat
- Light Brown Nimat
- Clear Vigil Guide
- Yellow Ceremony Team member
- Orange OR NOAC participant
- Orange with Black Stripe NOAC staff
- Green Chapter Chief
- White Lodge Vice-Chief

### Candidate - Blue

*OR* if Tapped-out (1991 or prior)

### Eagle Claws – Black

*OR* if current Lodge Chief - two white claws

*OR* if past Lodge Chief - one white and one black claw

### Universal Arrow Ribbon

*OR* Founder’s Award - red ribbon with gold arrow

*OR* Fred A. Zimman Distinguished Service Award - blue ribbon

*OR* if both awards - half red and half blue ribbon

### Vigil Honor pin, if Vigil Honor

### Lodge Totem, if Brotherhood member

### Wooden Vigil triangle, if currently a Vigil Honor candidate
